



Oil cap removal and attachment aid.

Many people have trouble getting a firm grip on the oil cap so this is what we did to Jack's plane oil cap.

This may hurt some but the handle is made from a Snap-on screwdriver bit which anyone can purchase separately from Snap-on. If you never see one of their trucks, then a good, slim screwdriver you are willing to purchase for the purpose or destroy.

The end was trimmed, the part heated to mate with the edges of the cap and the guts of the cap removed so as to not damage the gasket with the welding heat and to avoid most of the smoke which would come from the residual oil.

After the welds, chrome as for this one, or simply clean and paint to prevent corrosion.
