Because of various circumstances N7093 was tied down outside and not flown for six weeks. Returning home from vacation ! did a very thorough pre-flight inspection and other than a little water in the gas sumps and some airing up the tires all seemed A-OK. Again at the end of the runup I did a careful pre-flight check with full power run-up and all seemed in order.

Take off was normal but about 100 feet above ground I noticed a small object fall from where the headliner joins the windshield. It bounced off my pant leg and onto the floor. It was a wasp nest with live wasps in it! It was a small one but there were definitely wasps in it. For some reason they decided to stay with the nest for at least a few moments.

At that point I took my left foot off the rudder pedal and got my knee up real high because the nest was not down by my neels, rather just ahead of the seat cushion. I managed one good stomp and that took care of the bees but when ! looked out I found myself in a hard right turn with the wings steeply banked. I managed to get her straightened out. made some quick turns in the pattern and was grateful to be back on the ground

I shot some wasp spray into the cockpit and let it sit a while. It was an unusual and interesting experience which reminds me that while I've never seen a preflight check list that included looking for wasps' nests. it's not a bad idea to check just the same.



MAKE YOUR OWN DOOR LATCH SPRINGS FOR CESSNA 120 & 140

9-27-82

"Just a couple of lines to say hello and to pass on the construction details of a device to make door latch springs for 120s and 140s. I understand they are available from Cessna at their usual exorbitant prices. I was able to obtain one spring from Jean VanSant a couple of weeks ago which I managed to lose but not before I got the necessary dimensions from it so that a fixture could be made to duplicate the springs. So far I've made four of tnem, two for myself and two for Ed Burt. They work fine.

"I don't know that door latch springs with anyone except Ed & myself but feel free to publish the info enclosed.


"I hope that the details for this simple device are clear enough."

Fixture for Bending Door Latch Springs

Material: Aluminum Block 1-1/4" x 1/8" drill rod

Slot width should be just wide enough to accept the wire being used (.040 - .050 piano wire). Depth of slot not critical as long as the 3/8" between the bottom of the slot and the center line of the hole is maintained.



Aluminum Block


5/8" wide x 3" long x 1" thick (only critical dimension is the width).


Drill hole in block large enough to accept the 1/8" drill rod without too much slop.

The position of the slot is not critical as long as the bottom of the slot is the same distance from the top edge of the block as is the top of the hole.

After constructing fixture:

- Bend a length of piano wire (.040 .050 diam.) into a U shape so that it fits snugly around block with bottom of U in the end slot.
- 2. Insert drill rod in hole in block.
- 3. Bend wire over the drill rod (both legs of the U, that is) as tightly as possible making two complete turns, ending with the tail ends in line on the same plane as the end of the wire in the slot.





4. Remove drill rod. Snip ends of the spring to proper length, about 1-1/16" over all.


To install in the door the door latching mechanism should be removed by disconnecting rod from the door handle. Note how the present spring is positioned so that you can install the new spring the same way.

The springs do not go in easily but with a little patience, an extra hand and perhaps partial disassembly, the task can be done in a few minutes.

If this fixture is too much bother, I will be happy to bend up some springs for three dollars a pair.

TOP RUDDER HINGE ATTACHMENT

M. L. Sutton suggests we all take a good look at the upper hinge attachments on our vertical stabilizers. With no rudder locks, many have taken quite a beating. Common failure according to M.L. is in the method of attaching the hinge to the vertical stabilizer. In checking several 120/140s it appears that most have been re-fitted with various sizes of riv-nuts, or

bolts. It appears that the top "cap" on the vertical stabilizers has been removed to allow access to make these repairs. Our guess is that they were originally riveted before the "cap" was attached. If any member has more "official" information regarding the best repair method please pass it along.
